

USE OF INTERNET AND COMPUTER RELATED SYSTEMS

Clear Creek Elementary School District provides staff access to the electronic resources available on the Internet. The purpose of providing access to the Internet, is to support Classroom instruction and educational research by students in the district in conjunction With teacher/staff directed classroom study.

The Governing Board recognizes that technology provides ways to access the most current and extensive sources of information. Technology also enables students to practice skills and to develop reasoning and problem solving abilities. In addition, electronic resources foster workplace skills that may be transferable to new technologies. Every effort shall be made to provide access to technology in all the district's schools and classes.

All personnel have the specific responsibility to supervise student use of the Internet to ensure that only teacher assigned topics or research are accessed.

The system shall be used only for purposes related to education. Commercial, political and/or personal use of the district's system is strictly prohibited. The district reserves the right to monitor any online communications for improper use.

Teachers shall provide students with alternate means of conducting research or acquiring information for school required assignments or projects if a parent/guardian elects not to allow student Internet access.

All personnel must adhere to classroom and school rules and guidelines, obey any and all laws regarding access and use on the Clear Creek School District electronic networks. Use of the Internet connection is a privilege. Failure to adhere to any regulation may result in the termination of access to the District's network, equipment, and computer related systems.
