Department of the Air Force School Liaisons (SLs) are the central point of contact for commanders, military families, and school districts on Preschool-12th grade school matters. Speaking the dual language of military to educators and education to the military they are considered the Education Office for PreK-12 in the local community and state. They advocate for military connected students at the local, state and national level. Differences in local demographics, installation mission, and community characteristics significantly impact SLs function. The foundation of the program will be the same, but the implementation will look different.

Early Education Teacher Development Grant Funding Available!

Placer County Office of Education, in a consortium with Alpine, Amador, Colusa, Lake, Sierra, Sutter, and Yuba Counties, has been awarded grant funding for three years from the California Department of Education. The goal of this funding is to increase the number of highly qualified early education workforce available to serve in California State Preschool Programs (CSPP), Transitional Kindergarten (TK), and Kindergarten (K) classrooms.

College tuition support available for:

- Existing credentialed teachers
 - support in attaining 24 ECE units to teach TK
- Existing non-credentialed early childhood educators
 - support to earn Bachelor's degree, Multiple Subject Credential, or P-3 credential (coming fall 2023)
 - support toward earning additional ECE units for Child Development Permits
- Others interested in a career in Early Childhood Education, TK, K or P-3 (preschool - 3rd grade)
