- Discuss the test- make sure your child is not scared or anxious.
- Take a practice test with your child. Practice tests can be found at http://www.caaspp.org/practice-andtraining/index.
- Make sure your child gets a good night's sleep and a nutritious breakfast before testing.
- Review test results with your child and discuss with their teacher where they might need additional help.

Your child's teacher is the best place to start if you have other questions about testing or available accessibility resources.

Next, I need your help with some safety concerns l've observed recently. If you are parking for after school pickup, please walk over to student lines and escort your student through the parking lot for their safety. It is dangerous for students to be darting through the parking lot unescorted. Please show care to all our Cougars and reduce your speed in the parking lot.
