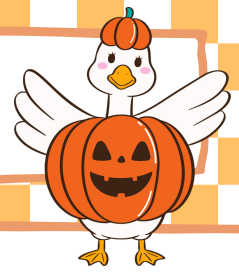

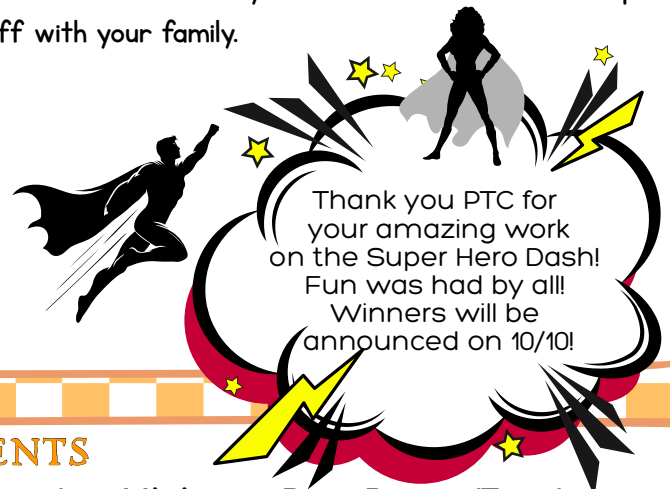
## Important Dates:

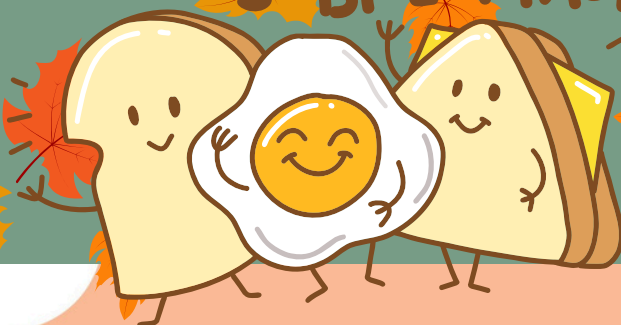

This exciting class will build strength and self-discipline while learning a traditional Korean martial art. Along with being introduced to Korean culture and language, students develop "Jung Shin"- a Korean word that means to focus your mind and heart 100% on what you are doing at any given moment.
